- -Motion passed to approve January 2013 minutes
- -Introduced Kate Hedstrom as new contract employee; working on WABL affairs and assisting with festivals

- -53 breweries took part on Washington Beer Open House
- -Partnership in 2013 with KEXP
- -E.D. will take part in meeting with organization seeking guidance on featuring Washington Beer at State Fairs

- -Balance sheet presented to the Commissioners

Festival Director's Report:

- -Belgianfest sold out again; \$2500 over budget; looking to grow attendance + food offerings next year
- -Winterfest: still seeking larger venue; possible move to early November
- -WA Brewers Fest: after one week 32 breweries already registered

WABL Report:

-Information + registration booth will be part of Cask Fest; currently 2600 members

New Business:

- -Dan Newhouse has been replaced by Bud Hover as Director of the Department of Ag
- -Odem (beer distributor) rep was introduced and expressed interest in coordinating efforts with the Mkt. Committee to promote Washington Beer
